Are you looking for a new challenge or to further your career? Then look no further, our Network team is currently looking to fill roles in both our Network Systems and Infrastructure team!

Network Analyst (Systems Analyst 1) - In this junior role you will provide operational support to the network team by:

- Monitor the Operations Queue, perform support calls, and assist senior analysts with technical issues and task priorities.
- Assist other AGLC technical teams to support and implement new technologies.
- Monitor the health of the network utilizing our Monitoring, reporting and logging tools such as SolarWinds Orion and Net flow tracker.
- Support the implementation of long term technological, procedural and network topology improvements related to the Network Operations group.
- Assist senior analysts to support operational needs as well as project work.

Network Analyst (Systems Analyst 2) - In this role you will provide general operational Network support to the organization. This will include, but is not limited to:

- Provide operational network support services to all business areas by analyzing and resolving technical issues on established or newly installed networks,
- Provide Tier 2 and 3 technical support for the Network Operations team,
- Develop recommendations for technical and procedural changes, to improve efficiency and effectiveness in all AGLC business areas,
- Monitor the health of the network utilizing our Monitoring, reporting and logging tools such as SolarWinds Orion and Net flow tracker.
- Assist members of the Network Infrastructure team, to develop and deploy new network architectures and infrastructure.

Network Analyst (Systems Analyst 3) - In this senior level role you will be responsible for the design, deployment, and troubleshooting of AGLC networking security technologies. This will include, but is not limited to:

- Design, deploy, configure and support AGLC's gaming and corporate network.
- Work closely with manufactures/vendors to evaluate and integrate new technologies into the production network.
- Provide onsite network support and expertise on data routing and switching.
- Identify/schedule network maintenance, repair, and upgrade tasks as needed while limiting the impact on the production network.
- Provide technical leadership and guidance during deployment activities
- Responsible for asset management of networking gear

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SKILLS/QUALIFICATIONS

- Related technical diploma (e.g. NAIT Computer, Telecommunications or Network Engineering Technology) or related University Degree (Computer Science or Engineering).

Network Analyst (Systems Analyst 1) - Minimum 1 years of Network or IT communications experience.

Network Analyst (Systems Analyst 2) - A minimum 3 years of experience of Network communications including switching, routing, firewall, Datacenter and hardware management. Experience with Cisco switches and routers as well as Cisco CCNA level certification or higher or -Global Information Assurance Certification (GIAC) would be considered an asset.

Network Analyst (Systems Analyst 3) - A minimum of 5 years of progressively responsible Network communications experience is required. This includes experience with the configuration and capabilities of Cisco ASA, Cisco FTD appliances, and Palo Alto Firewalls, IDS/IPS, internetworking technologies as well as experience designing and troubleshooting secure data network infrastructures.

NOTE: An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered. Candidates with lesser qualifications may be considered at a lower classification and salary. This recruitment may be used to fill future vacancies.
