

SPECIAL EVENT LICENCE PRIVATE NON-SALE INDUSTRIAL USE Policies and Guidelines

1. POLICIES

- 1.1 A Private Non-Sale Industrial Use licence authorizes the licensee to possess, store and use liquor in the licensed premises for the purposes of an industrial, mechanical, food processing or manufacturing business.
- 1.2 A Private Non-Sale Industrial Use licence is only issued by the AGLC.
- 1.3 The applicant must disclose the specific use of the liquor on the application form.
- 1.4 The application for a Private Non-Sale Industrial Use licence must include a copy of the current business licence.
- 1.5 The licensee is responsible for ensuring compliance with all legislation, policies and requirements governing the possession, storage and use of Industrial liquor.
- 1.6 A Private Non-Sale Industrial Use licensee must comply with the Special Event Licence General Policies and Guidelines.
- 1.7 The fee for a Private Non-Sale Industrial Use licence is \$10.00.
- 1.8 A Private Non-Sale Industrial Use licence is in effect for one year unless cancelled by the AGLC.
- 1.9 Liquor must be purchased from a Class D licensee. Ethyl alcohol must be purchased direct from suppliers. Records of liquor purchases must be maintained.
- 1.10 The sale of liquor is prohibited under a Special Event Private Non-Sale Industrial Use licence.
